Mission

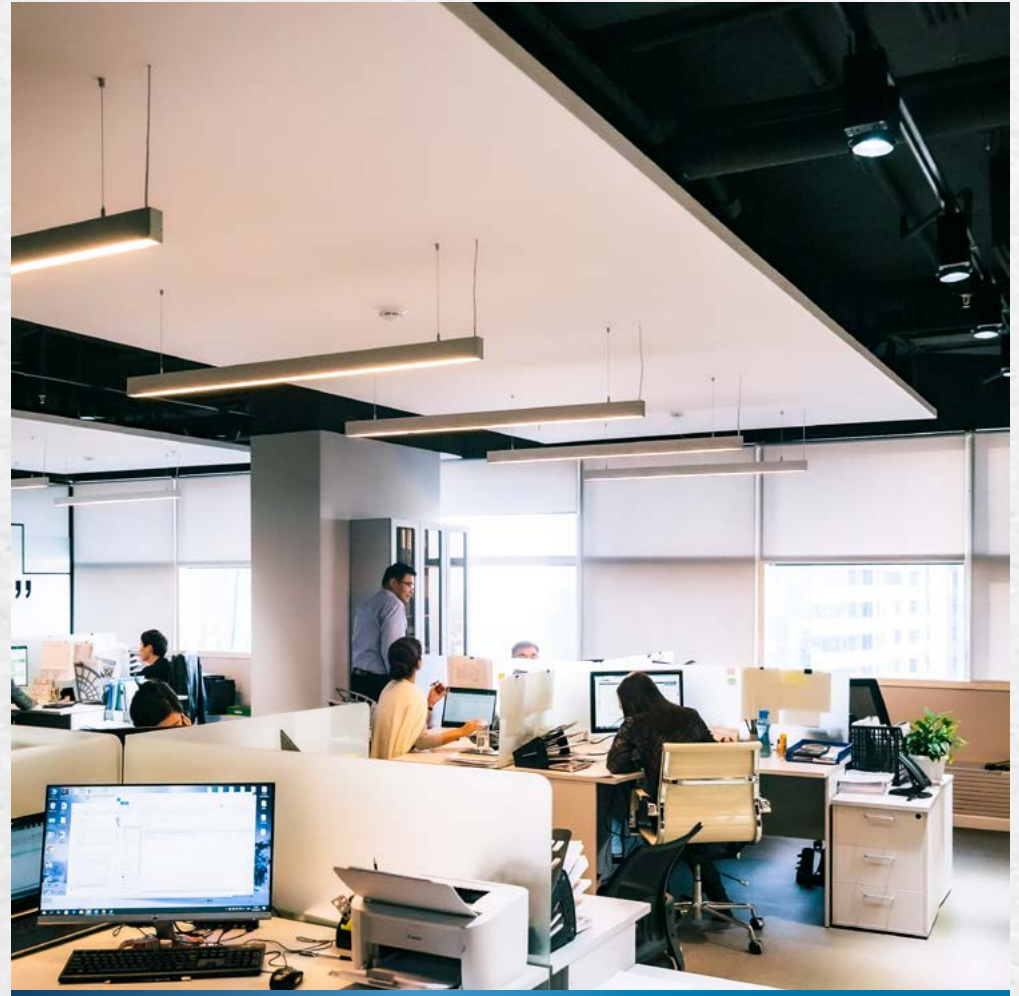
Changing the way addiction and recovery are understood and embraced through advocacy, education and leadership.

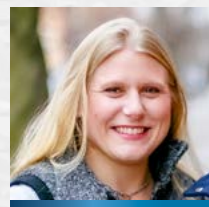
