### In Case of Emergency Settings on Cell Phones

#### iPhone (Apple) – Medical ID & Emergency SOS

##### Set Up Medical ID

- Open the Health app.
- Tap your profile picture (top right).
- Tap Medical ID > Edit.
- Add important info (conditions, medications, emergency contacts).
- Toggle Show When Locked ON.
- Tap Done.
-  In an emergency, first responders can access this from the lock screen by tapping Emergency > Medical ID.

##### Emergency SOS

- Press and hold the side button + volume button OR tap the side button 5 times quickly.
- iPhone will call 911 (or local emergency services).
- After the call, it sends your location to your listed emergency contacts via text.
- It updates them if your location changes.

### Android – Emergency Information & SOS

#### Set Up Emergency Info

- Open Settings.
- Tap About phone > Emergency information.
- Add emergency contacts and medical details.
-  Emergency responders can access this from the lock screen (varies by model, often under “Emergency” > “Emergency Info”).

#### Emergency SOS

- Go to Settings > Safety & emergency (or similar).
- Turn on Emergency SOS.
- Choose what happens when you press the power button 5 times:
- Call emergency services.
- Share your location.
- Send a text alert to selected contacts.

### Bonus Tip

Encourage people to name emergency contacts in their phone as "ICE" (In Case of Emergency) – e.g., ICE – Mom. First responders often look for this.
